Courts Maintenance

Of all the surfaces to play tennis, clay courts need the most maintenance. Our club's courts get a thorough rolling at the start of the year to create a consistent flat surface across all areas of the courts. But, the clay's water content must be balanced to provide a good surface throughout the year. For



this reason, our grounds keeper Stanley will be visiting the courts on a daily basis. Stanley has been maintaining our courts for a number of years. Depending on the weather, he visits the courts each day at different time to water the courts, brush the lines and/or sweep the playing surface to spread the clay. Please follow his instructions and vacate the courts during court maintenance.
